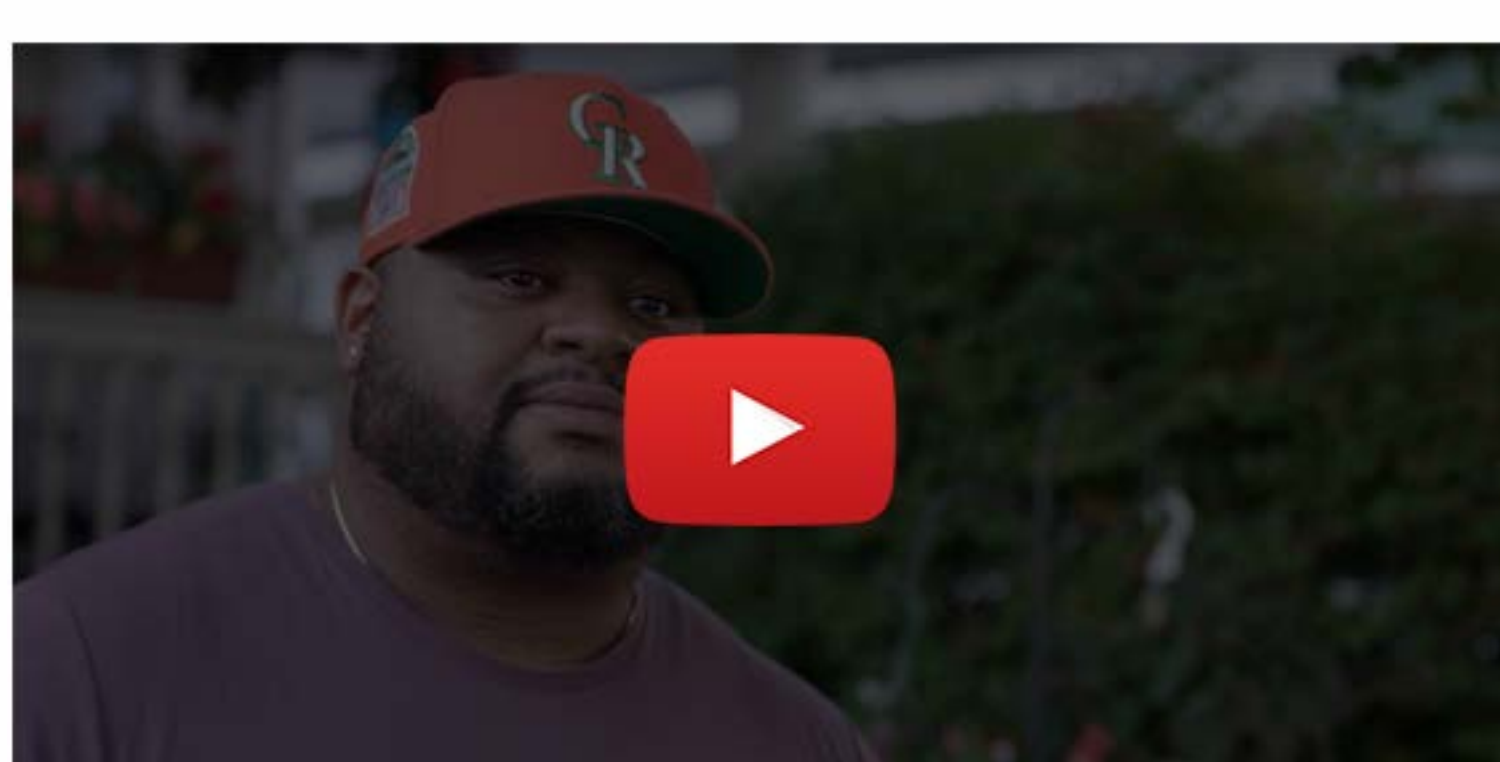
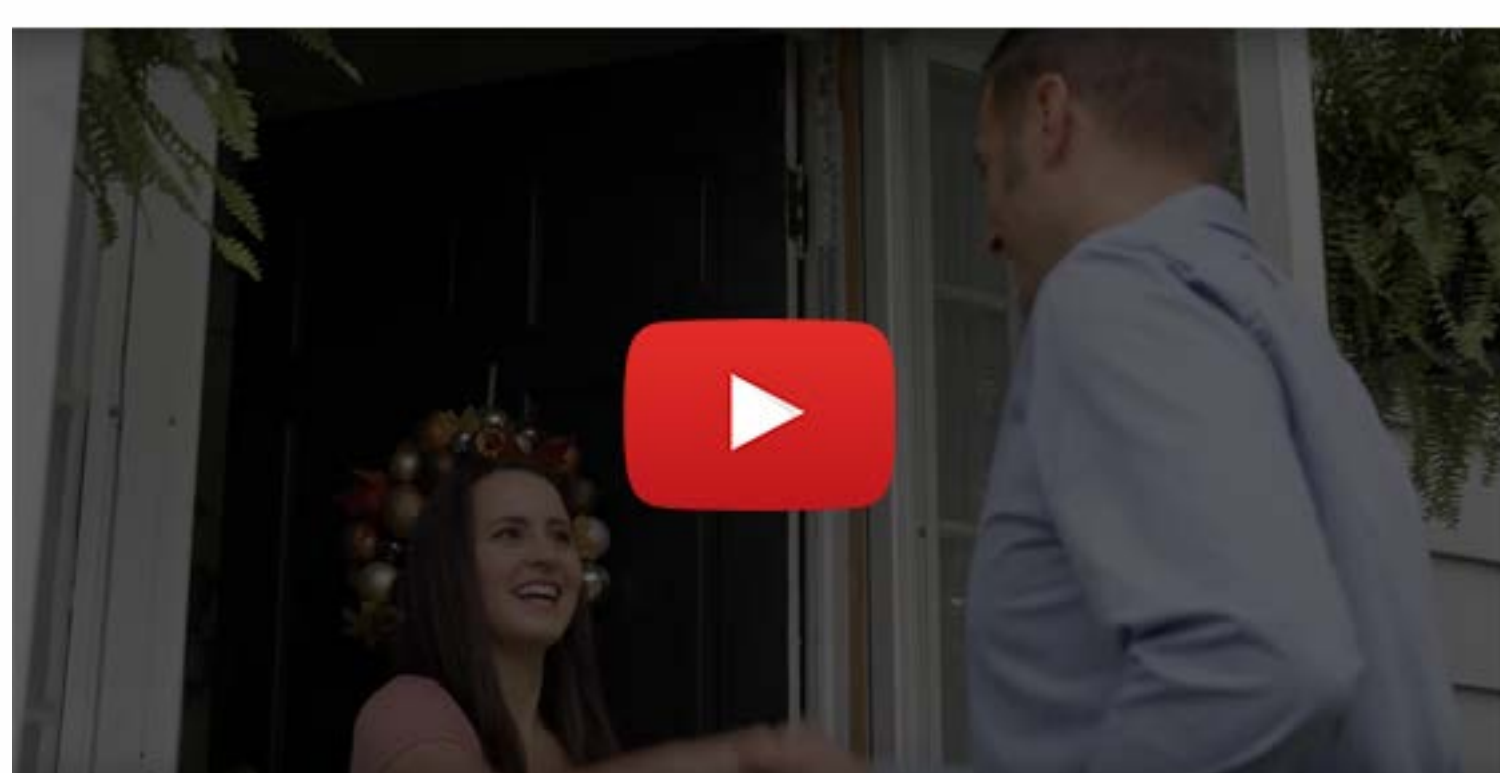
"Everything we do as a city depends on the strength of public safety. That is why **Public Safety is priority number one!**
